

## **Mobile Phone Use at School – Application for Exemption**

Mobile phone use by students at Hawkesbury High School is guided by General Management Procedures. However, a parent or a student may apply for an exemption from some of the procedures, in certain circumstances. If approved, a student with an exemption will be issued with a **Phone License** which clearly identifies the **purpose** and **place** where the student may be permitted to use their phone.

All applications for an exemption must be made directly to the Principal.
