Hawkesbury High School Uniform

Hawkesbury High School provides a high standard of education, safety and wellbeing for all its students. The Hawkesbury High school community; made up of students, parents and staff, view the wearing of school uniform as integral to maintaining these standards and the STAR (Safe, Team Player, Achiever and Respectful) values of the school.

The aim of these procedures is to ensure that the Hawkesbury High School uniform is worn by all students, that the school uniform at Hawkesbury High School reflects school and community standards as supported by the school's P&C and consistent with WHS, anti-discrimination and equal opportunity legislation.

School Uniform:

- Upholds school identity and promotes equity for all students
- Encourages individual pride in personal appearance and a positive image of the school in the wider community
- Promotes a sense of inclusiveness, non-discrimination and equal opportunity – students are not made to feel different as all students wear the same clothing
- Enables the quick identification of an intruder on school premises and reinforces the obligation to keep all students safe at school
- Protects students when using machinery, equipment or chemicals in practical subjects
- Identifies the school at representative sporting events and excursions
- Prepares students for the work place, as many occupations have a dress code or uniform requirement.

All school uniform items can be purchased at The School Locker shop which is located on the grounds of Hawkesbury High School.

The following are important requirements of the HHS school uniform procedures

- Students need to wear the correct uniform including travelling to and from school each day
- All items of school uniform are to be worn appropriately, respectfully, clean and in acceptable condition
- For timetabled sport or PDHPE practical classes students are to bring the correct HHS sports uniform to change into
- The following items are not permitted: Zone and representative jackets or pullovers, jeans, leggings, denim shorts, non HHS sport shorts, non HHS track suit pants, cardigans, hooded tops, undershirts or T shirts that extend beyond uniform clothing.

Please bring a signed note to the Front Office to explain when out of uniform.

When a student is out of uniform for any reason, the school requires that a note, signed by a parent/guardian, to be brought to school on the day and shown to the Deputy Principal in the morning before roll call. Students will then receive an “out of uniform pass” which any staff member may check throughout the day. Passes will only be issued on a daily basis. Consequences for where a student is out of uniform without a note include:

- Lunch detention supervised by the Deputy Principal or Head Teacher
- Being counselled by the Deputy Principal or Principal
- Students may be requested to change into items of uniform from the school clothing pool
- Record of the breach of school uniform rules on student referral system
- Record the number of breach of school uniform rules on student’s semester report

Parents will be contacted for those students who are regularly out of uniform to assist the school to determine if there is an underlying issue and if support is needed and so that parents can work with the school to ensure students can meet the required dress code.

Where families are experiencing financial difficulty limited student assistance funds are available to provide assistance with purchasing items of uniform. Please contact the Principal, in writing, to request assistance.

Students will be reminded on a regular basis about the correct procedures and the consequences for not wearing correct uniform.

Acknowledgement of the importance of the uniform as a school expectation and dress code occurs through the recognition and rewards program in the school.

Students consistently in correct uniform can earn VIVO points which contribute to their VIVO point balance.

The Deputy Principal and Year Advisors regularly acknowledge and reward students in correct uniform with tangible rewards.

SKIRT	Double pleated front blue, maroon & yellow tartan
SHORTS	Tailored plain navy blue shorts - mid thigh to knee length
PANTS	Plain navy blue slacks
HHS Track Pants	Tracksuit Pants Navy "HHS" microfibre
TOP	White polo shirt with school emblem or white blouse with school emblem
ZIP JACKET	Navy/maroon/sky blue microfibre jacket with emblem <i>(lined and unlined versions available)</i>
JERSEY	The SRC designed senior school jersey may be worn to school, but is not to be worn on special outings without specific approval
SHOES	Plain black leather lace up shoes with enclosed toes <i>(refer to poster indicating required footwear)</i>
SOCKS	Plain white socks for summer <u>or</u> flesh or black coloured stockings under skirt for winter

SENIOR GIRLS' SPORT UNIFORM - required for Representative Events

SHORTS	Navy "HHS" sport shorts with emblem
SHIRT	"HHS" sports shirt with emblem
SHOES	Joggers or sandshoes <i>(refer to poster indicating required footwear)</i>
SOCKS	White socks

Note: Jeans, leggings, footy shorts, denim shorts or non HHS sports shorts and non HHS track suit pants are NOT PERMITTED

SHORTS	Navy blue shorts – mid thigh to knee in length
HHS Track Pants	Tracksuit Pants Navy “HHS” microfibre
SHIRT	White polo shirt, with school emblem <u>or</u> Plain white shirt with collar and emblem
ZIP JACKET BLAZER	Navy/maroon/sky blue microfiber jacket with emblem <i>(lined and unlined versions available)</i>
JERSEY	The SRC designed senior school jersey may be worn to school, but is not to be worn on special outings without school approval
SHOES	Black leather lace up shoes <i>(refer to poster indicating required footwear)</i>
SOCKS	Plain white socks

SENIOR BOYS' SPORT UNIFORM – required for Representative Events

SHORTS	Navy “HHS” sport shorts with emblem
SHIRT	“HHS” Sports shirt with emblem
SHOES	Joggers or sandshoes <i>(refer to poster indicating required footwear)</i>
SOCKS	White socks

SKIRT	Girls skirt large blue check
SHORTS	Tailored plain navy shorts – mid thigh to knee in length
PANTS	Plain navy pants
HHS Track Pants	Tracksuit pants navy “HHS” microfibre
BLOUSE	Sky blue & maroon polo shirt with school emblem
JUMPER	Maroon poly/cotton with school emblem
ZIP JACKET	Navy/maroon/sky blue microfibre jacket with emblem. <i>(lined and unlined versions available)</i>
SHOES	Plain Black leather lace up shoes with enclosed toes <i>(refer to poster indicating required footwear)</i>
SOCKS	Plain white socks for summer <u>or</u> flesh or black coloured stockings under skirt for winter

JUNIOR GIRL'S SPORT/PE UNIFORM

SHORTS	Navy “HHS” sport shorts with emblem
T-SHIRT	“HHS” sports shirt with emblem
SOCKS	White
SHOES:	Joggers or sandshoes <i>(refer to poster indicating correct footwear)</i>

SHIRT	Sky blue polo & maroon shirt with school emblem
JUMPER	Maroon poly/cotton with school emblem
ZIP JACKET	Navy/maroon/sky blue microfiber jacket with emblem <i>(lined and unlined versions available)</i>
SHOES	Black leather lace up shoes <i>(refer to poster indicating required footwear)</i>
SOCKS	Plain white socks.

 	<p>Acceptable Boys Shoes</p> <p>Features;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Black Leather • Laced or Velcro • Upper Foot Protection • Non-slip sole
 	<p>Acceptable Girls Shoes</p> <p>Features;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Leather upper providing protection to the majority of the upper foot • Laced (preferred) • Heel and sole with non-slip grip
 	<p>Acceptable Sports Shoes</p> <p>Features;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Lace up/Velcro (NO slip ons) • Covers all of the top of the foot • Provides arch support, ankle support and sole protection.
 	<p>Unacceptable Shoes;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The majority of the upper foot is unprotected. • Smooth sole with little or no grip. • No token/heel. • Thin soft leather offering little protection. • Canvas upper eg. Rabens

**** Students undertaking practical based subjects need to wear lace-up shoes that protect their feet against drops and spills. OH&S requirements may result in students who are not wearing shoes with sufficient protection being excluded from some practical activities. If in doubt please purchase lace up shoes or contact the school.**
